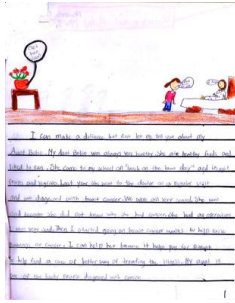


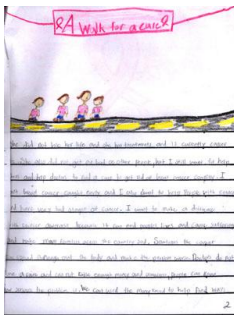
HOW CAN I MAKE A DIFFERENCE

“Find a Cure...Make a Difference”



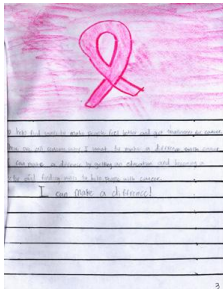
