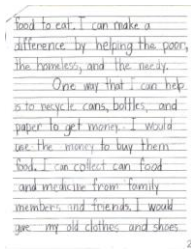


“I CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE BY...”

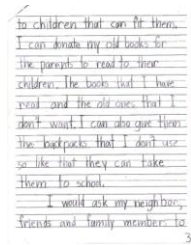


I feel I am a lucky kid because I have a nice family. I have a home to live in and



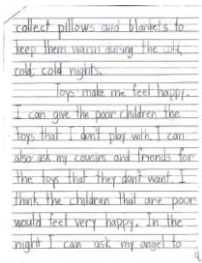
food to eat. I can make a difference by helping the poor, the homeless, and the needy.

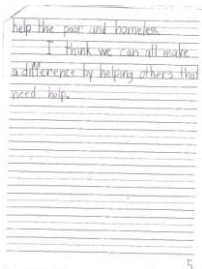
